Pursuant to Rule 154.602 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's ("Commission") Regulations, and to comply with the Commission's September 28, 2020 Order under Docket Nos. CP20-468-000 and CP20-474-000¹ ("September 28 Order"), Central Kentucky Transmission Company ("Central Kentucky") hereby requests to cancel its FERC Gas Tariff, First Revised Volume No. 1 ("Tariff").

Statement of Nature, Reasons and Basis for Filing

In the September 28 Order, the Commission authorized Central Kentucky to abandon, by sale to Columbia Gas Transmission, LLC (“Columbia”), its interest in certain certificated interstate pipeline facilities known as the KA-1 North Facilities. The Commission also directed Central Kentucky to cancel its Tariff in accordance with Section 154.602 of the Commission’s Regulations. Accordingly, to comply with ordering Paragraph H within the September 28 Order, Central Kentucky is submitting the following cancellation of its Tariff.

Section 154.602 of the Commission’s regulations requires a statement showing the reasons for the cancellation, a list of affected customers and the contract demand provided to the customers under the service to be cancelled.² Central Kentucky currently has two customers with service agreements on Rate Schedule FTS for 28,0000 Dth/day each, Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc. and Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc. However, the cancellation of Central Kentucky’s Tariff will have no adverse effect on any customer of Central Kentucky because, as the Commission noted in the September 28 Order, the transportation service agreements with Central Kentucky will expire upon Commission approval of the abandonment, and Columbia will offer similar gas transportation service to all customers previously served by Central Kentucky.³

Effective Date and Request for Waiver

Central Kentucky respectfully requests that the Commission grant a waiver of the thirty-day notice period set forth in Sections 154.206 and 154.207 of the Commission’s regulations to cancel its Tariff effective December 1, 2020. Central Kentucky anticipates the closing of the sale of the KA-1 North Facilities from Central Kentucky to Columbia and the abandonment of service by Central Kentucky to take place on December 1, 2020. Central Kentucky will file an update with the Commission once closing of the sale of the KA-1 North Facilities from Central Kentucky to Columbia is complete.

In accordance with Section 154.7(a)(1) of the Commission’s regulations, Central Kentucky is submitting the an eTariff XML filing package containing this transmittal letter and tariff record canceling its Tariff.


