Pursuant to Sections 154.501 and 154.502 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's ("Commission") regulations, and Article II of the Stipulation and Agreement ("Modernization II Settlement") approved by the Commission on March 17, 2016, Columbia Gas Transmission, LLC ("Columbia") hereby submits its report regarding the settlement payment of \$5 million to be provided upon issuance of the Commission order addressing Columbia's 5th year Capital Cost Recovery Mechanism ("CCRM") rate filing.

Statement of the Nature, Reasons and Basis for Filing

On December 18, 2015, Columbia filed its Modernization II Settlement representing an extension to its modernization program – a collaborative program between Columbia and its customers to address complex issues arising out of recent and anticipated changes in pipeline safety and environmental requirements, Columbia's ongoing efforts to enhance pipeline safety and reliability of service, and the age of Columbia's system. On March 17, 2016, the Commission approved the settlement on the basis that it is fair and reasonable and in the public interest.

Article II of the Modernization II Settlement provided that Columbia would make a settlement payment in the amount of \$5 million upon the issuance of a Commission order addressing Columbia's 5th year Modernization I CCRM rate filing. The settlement payment will be issued to customers that are firm contract holders under Rate Schedules FTS, NTS, NTS-S, TPS, SST, OPT, and GTS paying the full, then-current CCRM rate. The payment will be allocated based on the most recently available 12-month firm maximum daily quantity ("MDQ") history.

The Commission issued its order approving Columbia's 2018 CCRM rate filing on March 1, 2018.³ In accordance with Article II of the Modernization II Settlement, Columbia will issue the payment in its March 2018 billing cycle. The attached Appendix A details the settlement payment by customer updated for the most recently available MDQ. Columbia respectfully requests that the Commission accept this report in compliance with Article II of the Settlement.
