Statement of Nature, Reasons, and Basis for Filing

Millennium is making this filing pursuant to Section 34.11 of the General Terms and Conditions of its Tariff, in order to reflect negotiated rate transactions with certain customers for firm transportation services under Millennium's Rate Schedules FT-1 and FT-2 (collectively, the "Agreements"). The tariff records identify and describe the applicable negotiated rate transactions, including the exact legal name of the shipper, the negotiated rates, the rate schedule, the contract term, and the contract quantities.

Agreements

Millennium hereby submits the Agreements, as more fully described below:

- Contract No. 309614-2 between Millennium and Shell Energy North America (US)
 L.P. ("Shell") was previously filed at the Commission and is currently set forth in the
 Negotiated Rates Service Agreements Section in Volume 1.1 of Millennium's Tariff.²
 Millennium is merely amending the Statement of Negotiated Rates with an updated
 contract start and end date, a revised delivery point, and revisions to the commodity
 charge and revenue sharing mechanism.
- Contract No. 327858-0 is a new negotiated rate firm transportation agreement between Millennium and Sprague Operating Resources LLC ("Sprague"), which becomes effective November 1, 2025. Contract No. 327858-0 does not deviate in any material respect from the form of service agreement in Millennium's Tariff. Millennium is revising its Tariff to reflect the negotiated rate agreement with Sprague.
- Contract No. 317165-0 is a new negotiated rate firm transportation agreement between Millennium and CPV Valley, LLC ("CPV"), which becomes effective November 1, 2025. Contract No. 317165 does not deviate in any material respect from the form of service agreement in Millennium's Tariff. Millennium is revising its Tariff to reflect the negotiated rate agreement with CPV.
- Contract No. 151457-7 between Millennium and Coterra Energy Inc. ("Coterra") was previously filed at the Commission and is currently set forth in the Negotiated Rate Service Agreements Section in Volume 1.1 of Millennium's Tariff.³ Millennium is merely amending the Statement of Negotiated Rates with an updated contract start date and a point shift of 40,000 dekatherms a day to a new receipt point.
- Contract No. 328760-0 is a new negotiated rate firm transportation agreement between Millennium and NRG Business Marketing LLC ("NRG"), which becomes effective November 1, 2025. Contract No. 328760 does not deviate in any material respect from the form of service agreement in Millennium's Tariff. Millennium is revising its Tariff to reflect the negotiated rate agreement with NRG.
