Statement of Nature, Reasons, and Basis for Filing

Millennium is making this filing pursuant to Section 34.11 of the General Terms and Conditions of its Tariff, in order to reflect a negotiated rate transaction that it has amended with Coterra Energy Inc. (“Coterra”)² for firm transportation service under Millennium’s Rate Schedule FT-1 (“Amendment”). The tariff record identifies and describes the applicable negotiated rate transaction, including the exact legal name of the shipper, the negotiated rate, the rate schedule, the contract term, and the contract quantities.

The Coterra transportation contract was previously filed and accepted by the Commission, and is currently set forth in the Negotiated Rate Service Agreements Section in Volume 1.1 of

Millennium's Tariff.³ Millennium is merely amending the Statement of Negotiated Rates to reflect the removal of a receipt point for the Coterra transportation contract.

Millennium respectfully requests that the Commission accept the Amendment to become effective on April 1, 2026 and respectfully requests waiver of Section 154.207 of the Commission's regulations to allow for this effective date.⁴
