Dear Ms. Reese:

Pursuant to Section 4 of the Natural Gas Act (“NGA”), Part 154 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“FERC” or “Commission”) regulations,<sup>1</sup> Rule 212 of the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure,<sup>2</sup> and the Commission’s January 30, 2024 Order Accepting and Suspending Tariff Records, Subject to Refund, and Establishing Hearing Procedures in Docket No. RP24-287-000 (“Suspension Order”),<sup>3</sup> Northern Border Pipeline Company (“Northern Border”) hereby submits as part of its FERC Gas Tariff, Second Revised Volume No. 1 (“Tariff”) this Type 610<sup>4</sup> motion to place the certain suspended tariff records that are not subject to modification into effect on July 1, 2024.

## **Statement of the Nature, Reasons and Basis for Filing**

On December 29, 2023, in Docket No. RP24-287-000, Northern Border filed revised tariff records pursuant to Section 4 of the NGA and Part 154 of the Commission's regulations to implement a general rate case, propose a system-wide general rate increase, and included changes to Northern Border's rates, rate schedules and General Terms and Conditions ("GT&C") of its Tariff ("Rate Case Filing"). By its Suspension Order, the Commission accepted and suspended Northern Border's tariff records to become effective upon motion July 1, 2024, subject to refund and the outcome of the hearing procedures established in the Suspension Order.<sup>5</sup>

Northern Border is submitting the instant filing to move those certain suspended tariff records not subject to modification and listed in Appendix A, into effect July 1, 2024,<sup>6</sup> consistent with Northern Border's rights pursuant to Section 154.206 and the Suspension Order.<sup>7</sup>

### **Motion to Place Tariff into Effect**

Pursuant to Section 154.206 of the Commission's Regulations and Rule 212 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, Northern Border hereby moves to place those certain suspended tariff records not subject to modification, and included herein as Appendix A, into effect July 1, 2024. Northern Border requests that the Commission grant any waivers necessary for the proposed tariff records to become effective as requested herein.

### **Other Filings Which May Affect This Proceeding**

Contemporaneously with the instant filing, Northern Border is filing a separate Type 580 compliance filing in Docket No. RP24-287-000 providing revised plant in-service balances for each of its facilities to reflect anticipated plant balances as of July 1, 2024 to comply with Ordering Paragraph F of the Suspension Order.
